He was discharged from Fort Laramie (Present day Torrington, Wyoming) on October 8, 1859 after 4 years, 11 Months, and 11 Days of service. He served in the military on Dec 13 1861 in Camp Anderson, Jefferson County, Kentucky (Civil War). He was released on December 22, 1862 because of medical reasons. To Capt G. Welling, Comadg Fourth Regt Ky Cavalry

Sir,

For some time past my health has been very bad, occasioned by contracting a serious cold, which threatens to change into consumption, a hereditary disease in my family, of which my father died and my brother, also in the army and in this regiment and now at Hospital in Louisville suffers. I have been disabled in consequence of my illness to attend to my most ordinary duties and am entirely unfit for active field duties. Under the circumstances I deem it but just to relinquish my position, to be filled by some other officer more able to perform the duties than I am. I beg leave therefore, to render you this my resignation and hope you will approve of and forward it at your earliest opportunity.

William C. Blume, 67, a farmer in the Celestine community, died at 1:50 a.m. today in Memorial Hospital. He was a veteran of World War I.

Mr. Blume, who had been in failing health for some time, was taken to the hospital in an ambulance around 10 a.m. Sunday after his condition became worse as the result of an embolism.

He was born at Celestine on April 13, 1894, the son of Joseph and Elizabeth Miller Blume.

On April 12, 1921, he was married to Elizabeth Miller, who bore the same name as his mother. She survives, along with four sons, Othmar of Indianapolis, William M., Leo and Maurice, all at home; a daughter, Helen, at home; two sisters, Miss Anna Blume and Mrs. George Acra, both of Indianapolis; and two grandchildren.

Two brothers and two sisters are deceased.

He was a member of the St. Celestine Men's Sodality.

He spent his youth in his home town and on April 17, 1888 was united in marriage with Miss Theresa Kordes. To them 8 children were born, 6 of whom beside his wife survive him. They are; Mrs. John Neuhaus, Cambridge, Nebr., Emil and Theodore of Indianola, Nebr., Mrs. Garet Reining and Mrs. A.J. Buschkoetter of Lawrence and Mrs. Leo Gabel, Amarillo, Texas. A son John, died 18 years ago and a daughter, Mrs. John Reining passed away in 1937.

After spending his early married life in Indiana he moved, with his family in 1902, to Nebraska settling on a farm near Lawrence

Several years later Mr. Blume became afflicted with a severe case of asthma and in 1916 the family moved to Texas, thinking to restore his health by a change of climate,

After his children had married he and Mrs. Blume returned to spend their declining years in Lawrence. In 1928 they celebrated their golden anniversary.
